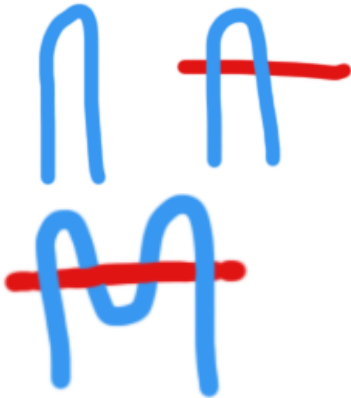
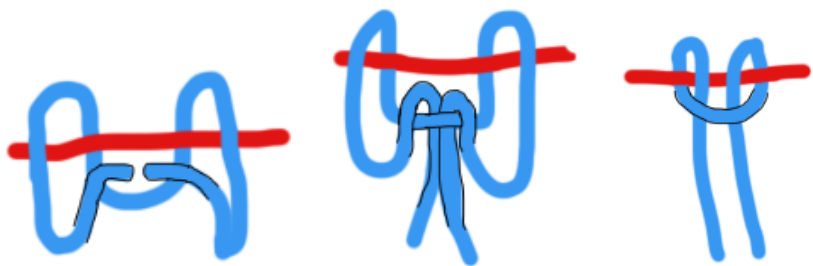


Knot Making Tutorial for a Net
Difficulty level: Medium
Recommended material: Yarn or thick cord

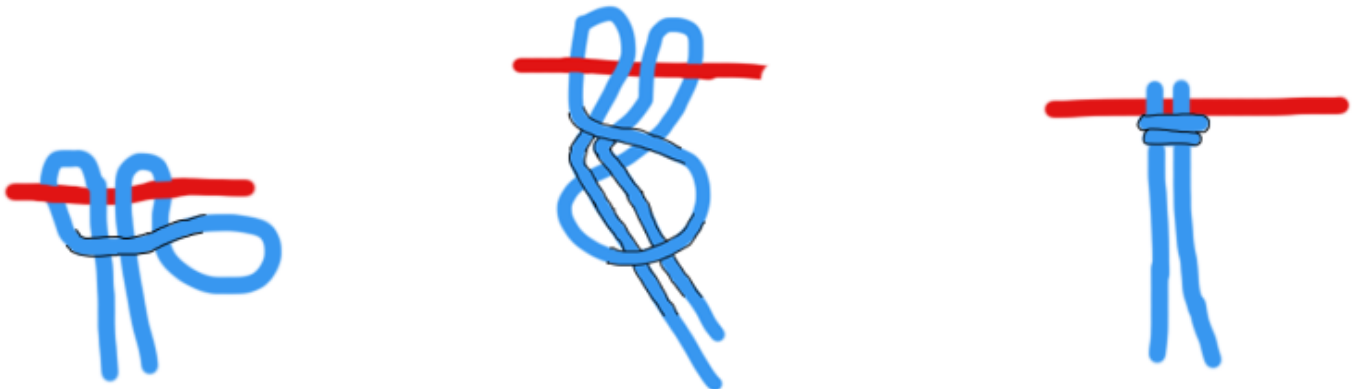


Step 1: Fold a piece of yarn or cord, then fold over a second piece of yard or cord.

Step 2: pull loose ends of yarn or cord through the loop to secure it on the second piece of yarn or cord.



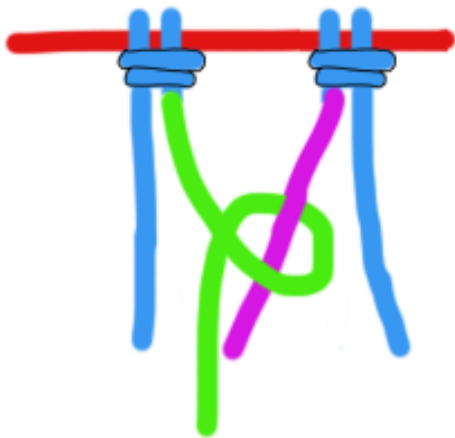
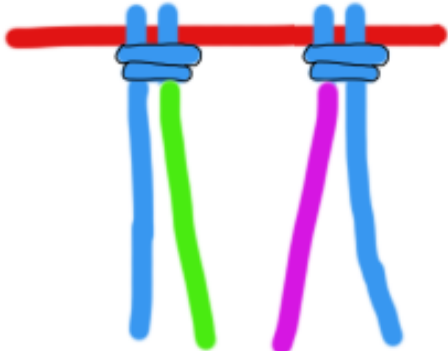
Step 3: twist the loop end keeping the loose ends of the yarn or cord behind it, then pull the loose ends through the new loop and tighten. Repeat for 2-3 strands.



Knot Making Tutorial for a Net

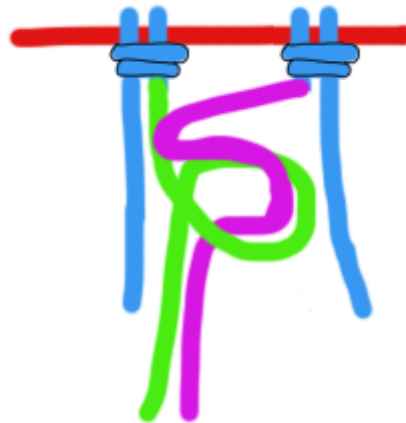
Difficulty level: Medium

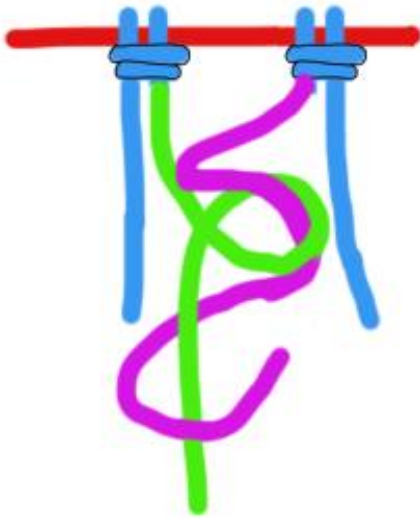
Recommended material: Yarn or thick cord



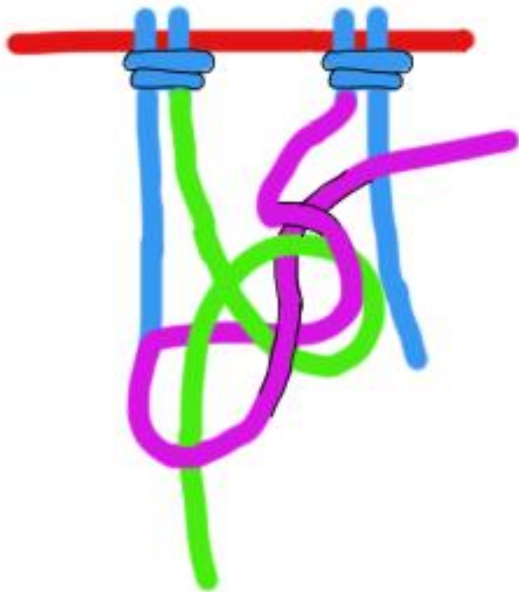
Step 1: Wrap strand #2 (shown as green) around strand #3 (shown as purple here)

Step 2: Holding strand #2 and #3 with your thumb and finger, push strand #3 (purple) to match the loop of strand #2 (green)





Step 3: Make a second loop with strand #3 (purple) around strand #2 (green) further down, then pull strand #3 (purple) through the first loop making sure to keep right of strand #3 (purple)



Step 4: Repeat for other strands, and repeat further down the strands to make a net.
